



Toe-Tac-Tic

What You Need

- paper
- pencil



- 1 Draw** a tic-tac-toe board.
- 2 Choose** one person to be “X” and another person to be “O”.
- 3 Play** the game just like Tic-Tac-Toe, but try **NOT** to get three-in-a-row.
- 4** The person who gets three-in-a-row first loses the game.

Wesley F. of Hiram, GA sent us another Tic-Tac-Toe game that he calls Rota. You need 2 players for this game. To play, draw a circle on a piece of paper and divide it into eight slices of pie. Give each player 3 game pieces. Players take turns putting their game pieces on any line in the circle, including the middle. Once they've put all 3 pieces on the board, they can move them from line to line, but only to one that's next to the line that they're on. The player who gets three in a row first wins.
